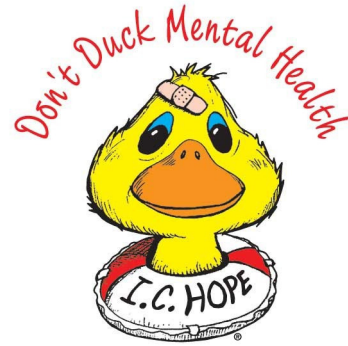




Tennessee Lives Count Project Trainer

The Project Trainer for the TLC youth suicide prevention and early intervention juvenile justice project will provide resiliency and suicide awareness training to youth and young adults in the juvenile justice system, provide suicide prevention training to juvenile justice staff and other community-based adult leaders working with youth and young adults, assist in updating resource directories and other marketing materials, serve as a resource in the community for suicide prevention and participate in conferences and meetings related to youth suicide prevention. Bachelor's degree required, with master's degree in social work, counseling, or psychology preferred; experience working with youth and youth service agencies preferred. Experience in the areas of suicide prevention and/or crisis intervention preferred. Must have word processing and spreadsheet skills, as well as great familiarity with Microsoft Office products. Must have a valid driver's license and be available for overnight travel statewide 75% of the time. Training/presentation experience required.
